

# Skating Informational Sheet

1. Skate School - Skate school fees and days are listed below. The session fees cover four lessons.
  - a. Skate School lessons will be offered on Saturdays from 10:00 to 12:00 as follows:
    - 10:00 – 10:45: Power Stroking, Moves in the Field, Footwork (Must be approved by Coach)
    - 10:45 – 11:30: Synchro Group(s)
    - 11:30 – 12:00: Group Lessons - All Levels
  - b. Each session will consist of 4 classes. The class dates will be available at registration. There are no refunds for missed classes. Do not pay for dates you are unable to attend.   - c. **Sessions must be paid for in advance.** No one will be permitted on the ice if their fees are not paid.
    - Pricing per session is as follows:
      - Group lessons \$60
      - Power Stroking classes \$60
      - Synchro Class \$60 (If taken in combination with the Power stroking class, the fee is \$100 for both)
    - Discounts are as follows:
      - Second child discount, \$5 per session (This discount only applies 1 time per Session.
  - d. Power Stroking classes will be offered to eligible students. Additional information is available from your coach.
  
2. Club Ice is additional practice time for skaters. To skate during these sessions your **ISI membership must be current**, and you must be either enrolled in the skate school program or taking lessons from a contracted skate school coach. Many of these sessions are "split-level", which means that the upper level skaters (freestyle 4 and up) can skate from 4:30 to 5:30 and the lower level skaters (freestyle 4 and below) can skate from 5:00 - 6:00. Level FS4 may skate on either session, but will need to pay for both sessions if they skate both sessions. See the "General Club Ice Schedule" for more information. The cost for regular Club Ice is \$10.00 for non-club members and \$7.00 for club members provided their dues are current. All skaters/participants will be required to sign the "Club Ice Code of Conduct for Parents and Skaters" before participating.
  
3. (Sun City Blades Figure Skating Club) Club membership permits you to skate on Club Ice at a discounted fee but there are also obligations that come with being a club member. Club members must participate in fundraisers, community service, and attend meetings regularly. If the obligations are not met, then discounted skating fees are discontinued. Detailed information is outlined in the club's bylaws. In addition, members are added to the club's email list so that they can receive changes to the practice times and other information via e-mail. The fee for club membership is \$120 per year for competitive members (This is a yearly commitment (\$120) and can be paid all at once or in payments provided at least \$10 is paid per month by the first of each month) and \$35 per year for Adult Recreational members.
  
4. ISI Membership - ISI is the Ice Skating Institute and membership provides insurance coverage for the skaters, coaches, etc. **Every skater participating in Club Ice must have a current ISI membership.**
  
5. Competitions/Exhibitions – The Sun City Blades sponsors and attends skating competitions and exhibitions throughout the year. Check with your coach for additional information.
